

Dress Code

On the Course

Smart golf attire is required.

Shirts need to have collars and sleeves. Ladies shirts must have collars and/or sleeves.

Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Men need to wear knee length smart shorts or tailored long trousers. Men may wear shorts only with <u>long or</u> <u>mid-long stockings</u>.

Hats, visors and caps are permitted but must always be <u>worn the right way</u> <u>round</u> (with peak forward)

Track-suits, t-shirts and worn jeans are forbidden.

Golf shoes are to be worn.

Golf shoes with metal spikes are permitted on the course (but not in the bar).

In the Club House Bar

Smart casual or smart golf attire is required.

Shirts need to have collars and sleeves. Ladies shirts must have collars and/or sleeves.

Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Men need to wear knee length smart shorts or tailored long trousers. Men may wear shorts only with <u>long or</u> <u>mid-long stockings</u>.

Hats, visors and caps can not be worn inside the Club House.

Track-suits, t-shirts and worn jeans are forbidden.

Golf shoes with metal spikes are not permitted.

For Prize Giving

Prize winners (men) are requested to wear a jacket and tie.

Smart casual attire is required for all people attending the prize giving.

In the Club House Dining Room

A <u>jacket</u> and tie must be worn at official dinners.

A tie is not required at informal dinners.
